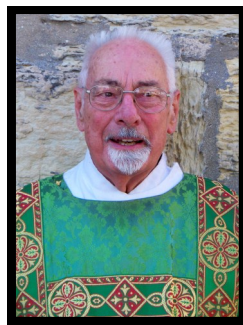

The first day we had 3,000 hits and it soared from there. We received e-mails, phone calls, and Facebook messages from people all over asking for the music, CDs, iTunes, anything we had nothing.

We headed back into the studio this past spring.

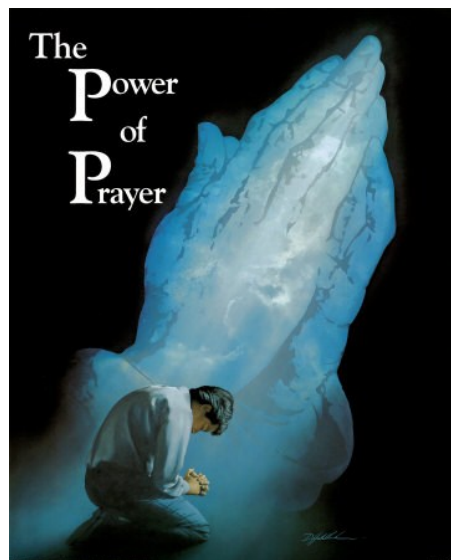
Welcome TECites of TEC 177

In a recent interview with The Catholic Post on her three-month stay in Cameroon, Africa, Sister Anne Germaine Picard said, “The poor are no longer just a concept in my head, but in my heart.”

While in Africa, Sister Anne Germaine, and Sister Suzanne Stahl, assistant Provincial Superior of the Sisters of Mary of the Presentation’s American

Province, taught English to the children in the schools, went to parish meetings, visited prisons where the Sisters minister, and helped to clean seven rooms in a maternity hospital.

Community, and is open to the public, on Jan. 22, from 7 to 9p.m. at the TEC Center Gym.
